Where We Are Today

- **AYP:** The number of schools meeting AYP has increased from 26% to 62% since 2007.
- **IRI:** The number of 3rd graders reading at grade level has increased from 66% to 75%.
- **NAEP:** 8 states outperform Idaho 8th graders in reading; 11 states outperform Idaho 8th graders in math.
- **Graduation Rate:** For every 100 students, 92 graduate from high school.

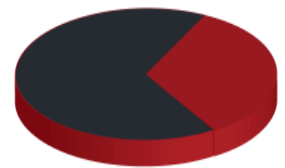
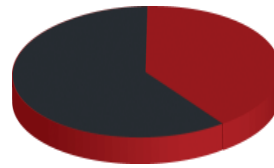

Increase in key ISAT measures	6 th Grade Math- 77.5% 8 th Grade Reading- 92.6% 8 th Grade Math- 79.5% 8 th Grade Language Usage- 71.2%
Idaho Reading Indicator	3 rd Grade- 75%
National Assessment of Educational Progress (NAEP)	8 th Grade Reading- 81% 8 th Grade Math- 77%
SAT scores	<i>Baseline data to come</i>
Increased graduation rate	92.4%
Increase number of students going on to postsecondary education	46%
Decrease in need for remediation	40%
Increase in the number of college courses taken in high school	47,000 credits
Eliminate the achievement gap	87%; 30%
Increase number of adults with postsecondary certificate or degree	34%
