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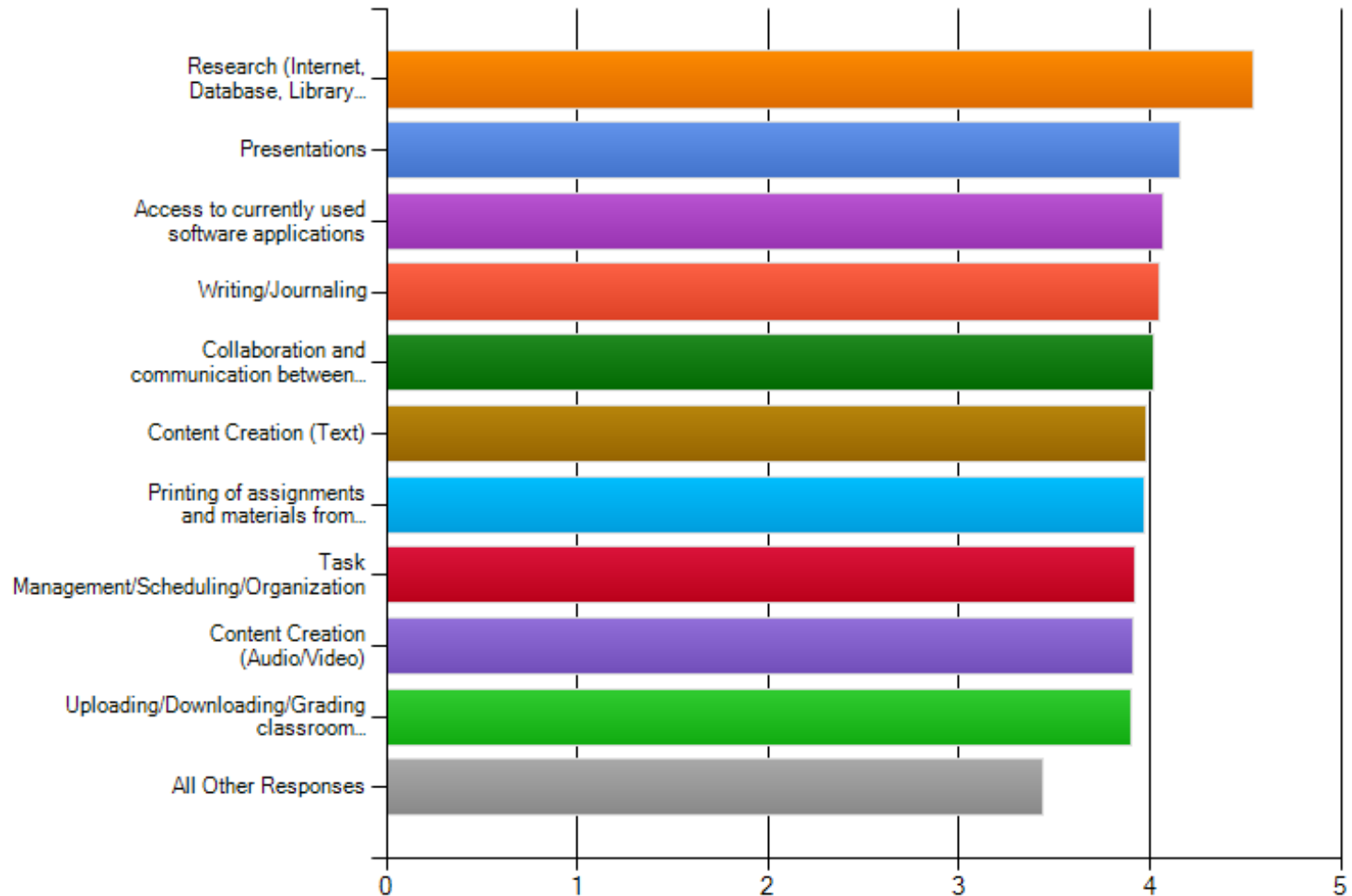

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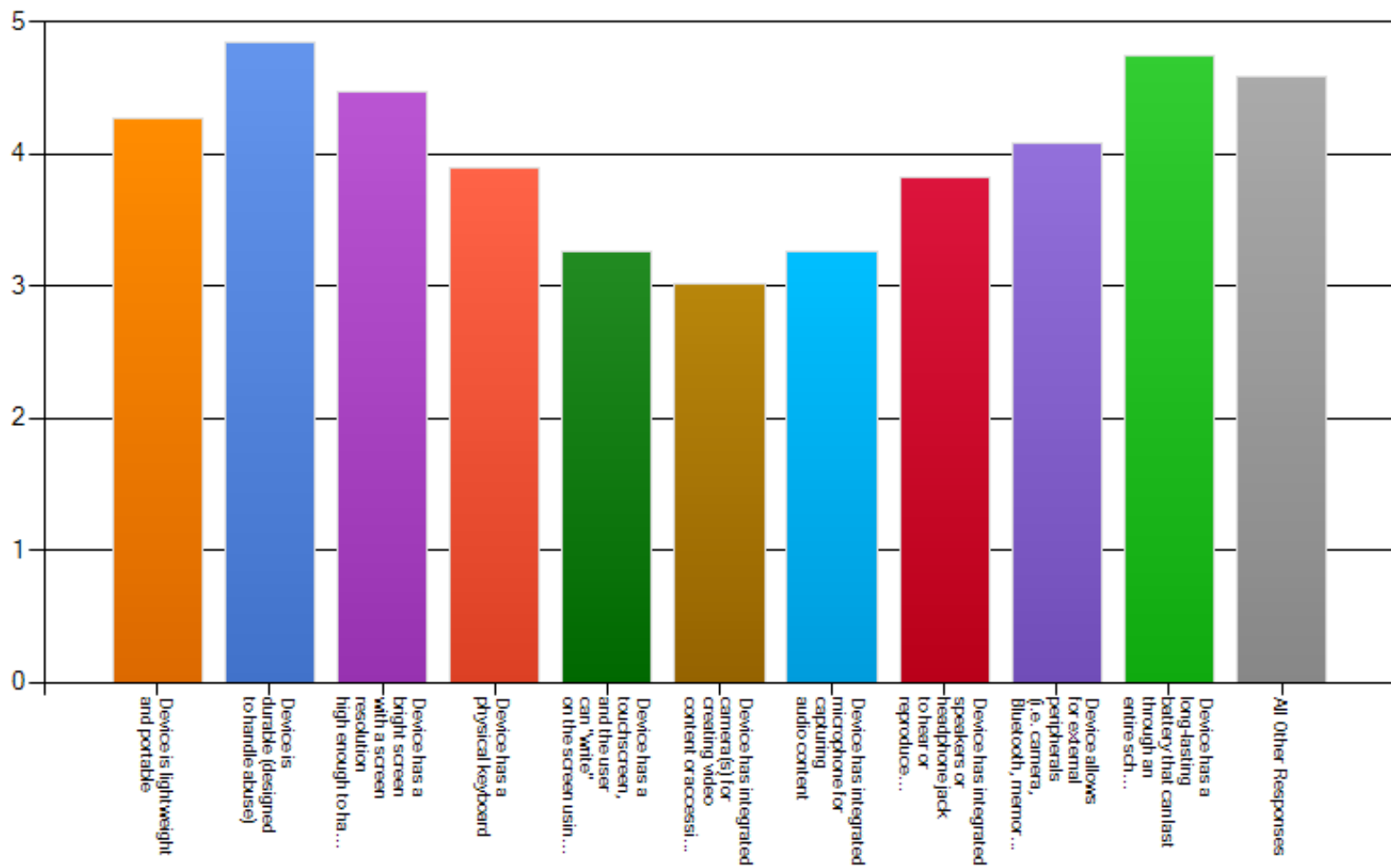
Please look at the following list of tasks that can be performed on a mobile computing device. How important is it to you that the device provided through the one-to-one implementation is able to perform each task?



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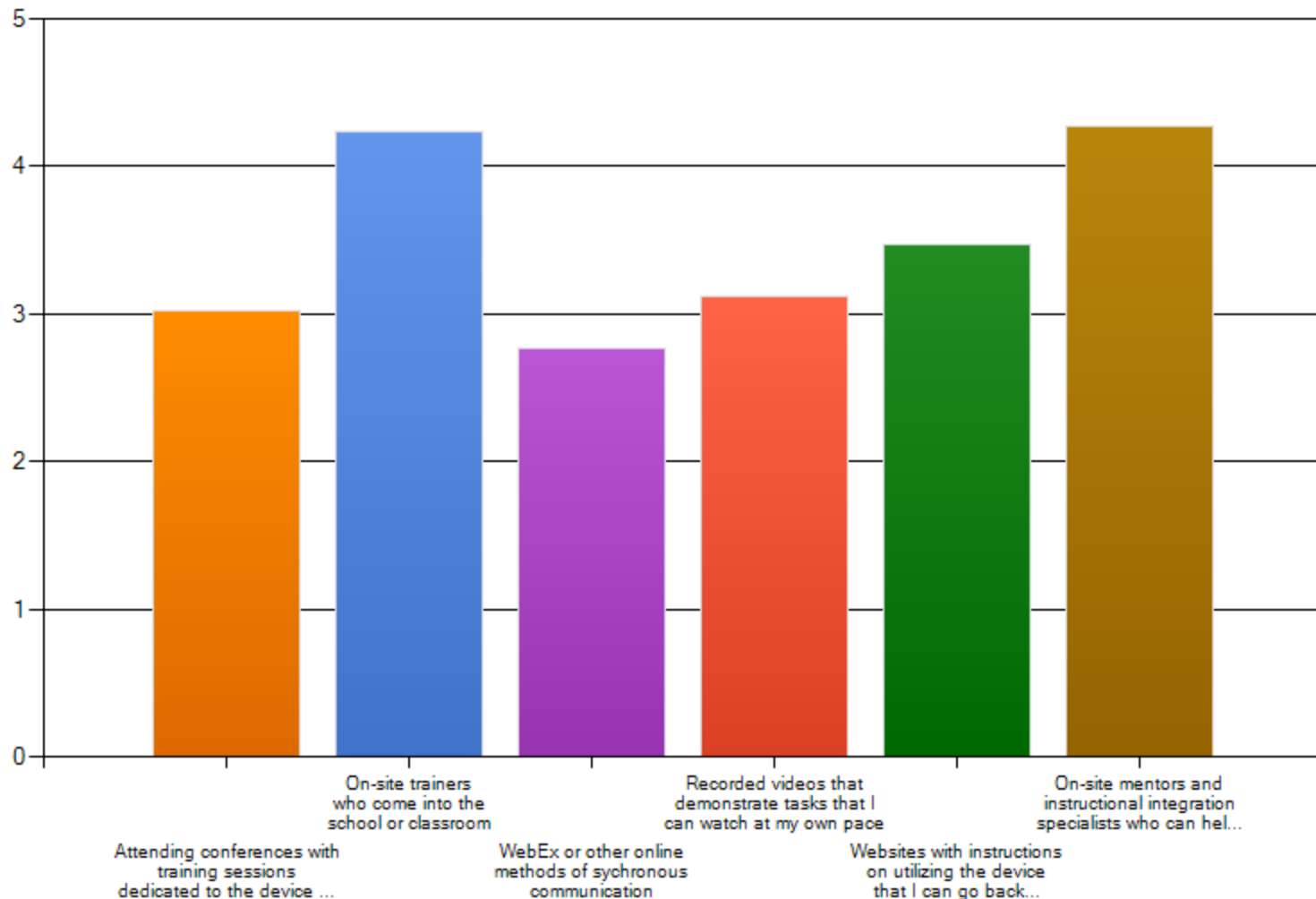

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Professional development or training could be delivered in many different methods. Please rate the effectiveness of the following methods of training from 1 (poor) to 5 (best).





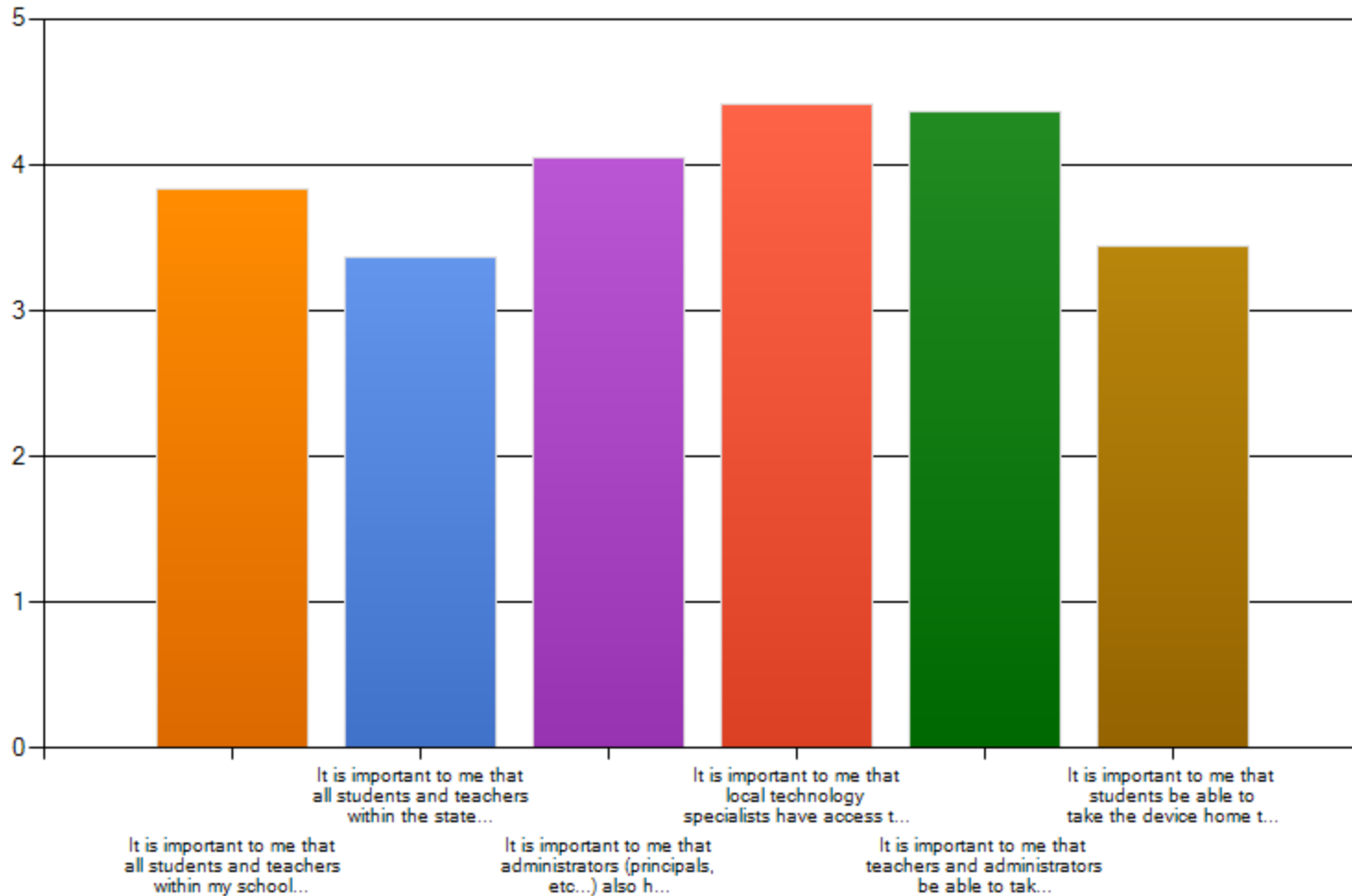

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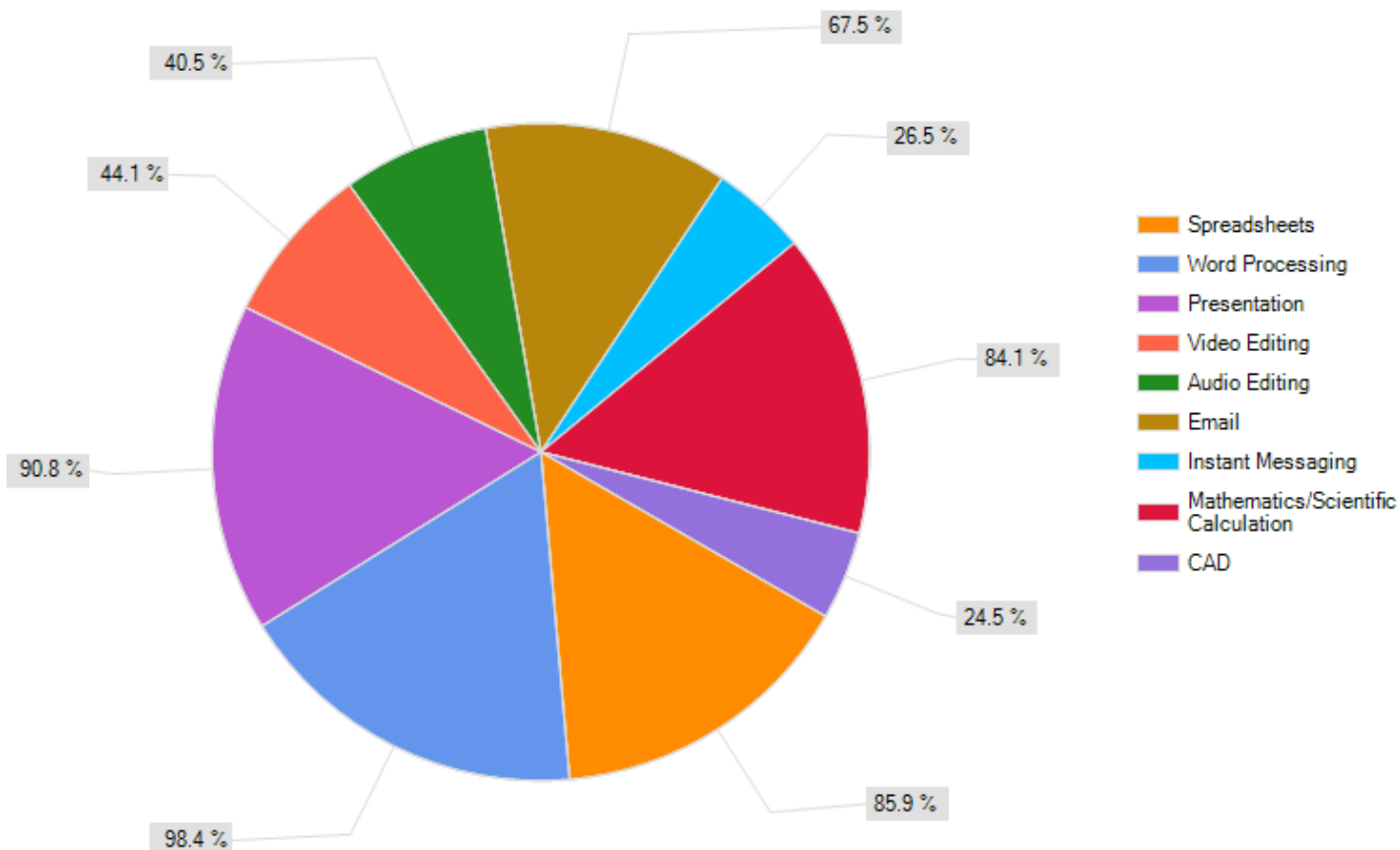
