Brady Kraft, Idaho Education Network (IEN), gave a presentation on his visit to Maine. Grades 7 through 12 received Apple devices. He noted that there was a clear definition defining connectivity. The vendor was responsible for the first deployment of wireless. Schools are allowed to continue using software with which they already own licenses to. Students turn in their device at the end of each year, much like textbooks. Teachers have access to YouTube, but students do not.

Mr. Kraft discussed the role of the vendor, tech support for devices and the role of the IEN. Maine's Technology Coordinator is willing to present to the Committee and answer questions.

The Committee discussed device maintenance, damage and training policies.

The Committee plans to have the RFI done by the end of the week.
